Antonio Garra was a Native American patriot who fought for Southern California and Northern Baja Tribal rights and Sovereignty. He was illegally executed on January 10, 1852 by the citizens of California during a mass anti-Native American hysteria at the beginning of statehood. When Garra was asked to state any last words, he replied, "Gentlemen, I ask your pardon for all my offenses, and expect yours in return."
